Main Street Manning

Main Street Manning, a department of the City of Manning, is accepting applications for its Façade Project. The Façade Project is a program of Main Street Manning that the City of Manning has elected to make available to the businesses located within the nine-block area of downtown. The Façade Project is a competitive grant process. If selected as a recipient of the 2016 Façade Grant you will receive up to four thousand dollars towards the cost of renovating the façade. In addition you may request an architectural rendering from Community Design Solutions. The money will not be awarded until after the work is completed. You will have a year from signing the façade funding agreement to complete work. Applications can be picked up from City Hall and the deadline to apply is June 16, 2016.
