- I. Welcome/Introductory Remarks:** Mayor Nelson welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- II. Invocation:** Councilmember Ervin Davis, Sr.

- IV. Approval of Agenda:**

A **motion** was made by Councilmember Welle and was seconded by Councilmember Gordon to approve the agenda as presented. There was no discussion. All favored the motion.

**V. Hearing on Business License Revocation.**

Councilmember Georgia **recused** herself from participating in the hearing or in any discussion due to a family member having a vested interest.

Next, Mayor Nelson gave instructions to the audience concerning the conduct of the meeting and then turned the meeting over to Attorney William Johnson to preside on behalf of Council.

Attorney Johnson stated that he was advised that there was an agreement reached between the attorneys for both sides. Attorney Johnson stated that the proceedings would be turned over to Attorney Adam Mandel, Attorney for the City of Manning, to present their case and then turned over to Mr. Servance and his Counsel.

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Following the conclusion of the hearing, a **motion** was made by Councilmember Welle and was seconded by Mayor Pro-tem Pack to enter into Executive Session to discuss the business license revocation. There was no discussion. All favored the motion.

A **motion** was made by Mayor Pro-tem Pack and was seconded by Councilmember Welle to return to Open Session. There was no discussion. All favored the motion.

Time: 9:25 pm

A **motion** was made by Councilmember Davis and was seconded by Councilmember Gordon to sustain the revocation but suspend that revocation upon the compliance of Mr. Servance with the following conditions as stated by Council's Attorney, William H. Johnson.

Next, Attorney Johnson outlined the conditions as follows:

1. The complete implementation of the security plan as proposed by Mr. Servance and the augmentation of that plan with the additional provisions:
  - a. Cameras will be installed at all entry points sufficient to provide coverage of all interior and exterior areas of the premises.
  - b. The recordings of the surveillance shall be maintained for a period of not less than 30 days.
2. The business hours of operations will be limited to open no later than 2 a.m.
3. No loitering after hours.
4. Upon the occurrence of one violent offense as defined by the S.C. Code, to include the use of any firearm, the suspension will be over and the revocation will be placed in effect.
5. Upon the confirmation by the Manning City Council Public Safety Committee of the occurrence of three non-violent reportable incidents, to include the violation of the city's noise ordinance, the suspension will be over and the revocation will be enforced immediately.

Following, Attorney Johnson stated that the written order will be issued within seven days of today's date and that the suspension continues until the order has been issued by Council.

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The motion was seconded by Councilmember Gordon. There was no discussion. All favored the motion.

**VI. Adjournment:**

A **motion** was made by Councilmember Welle and was seconded by Councilmember Gordon to adjourn. There was no discussion. All favored the motion.
